Acadience Progress Monitoring and Benchmarks Data - Over the past 6 years our Acadience data has held steady with an overall proficiency of 37% at the end of the year. Last year in 23-24 Heartland was able to increase student reading proficiency to 52% on or above benchmark at the end of the year. Current school year data, 24-25, indicates that we are on a similar trajectory at or middle of the year assessment to have the same or more students scoring at or above benchmark at the end of the year.	e our
Action Steps	close

1. We will hire or retain a BTS teacher (.6) to supplement our .4 allocation (\$49,000), and an additional literacy assistant (\$10,000)

- 2. We will create a PLC schedule and provide PLC time for teachers to meet at multiple times weekly to discuss data, group students by reading skills, and plan lessons for intervention and enrichment. Students will need to be enriched and supervised during this PLC time. The .6 FTE BTS teacher will cover classes while teachers meet to PLC.
- 3. The literacy assistant will help the teachers implement the lessons plans that are create during their PLC time. This will allow us to divide students by reading skill need and have smaller groups during intervention and enrichment time.

BACK UP PLAN

Should we be unable to hire or retain a .6 BTS teacher or a literacy assistant the following will be the backup plan for those expenditures.

- 1. We will purchase school wide literacy software (\$10,000)
- 2. Purchase additional Chromebooks to maintain our school 1:1 student to chromebook ratio and to replace outdated devices. (\$20,000). Students would use their chromebooks to access the literacy software, reading online, and access teacher prepared reading activities. These Chromebooks would be used during PLC rotations and beyond to support literacy and other learning.
- 3. Hire a part or full time teacher or assistant who could teach an alternate rotation so teachers can still have their PLC time to meet multiple times weekly to discuss data, group students by reading skills, and plan lessons for intervention and enrichment.. (\$30,000)
