Other Business:

<u>Cold Weather</u>- Same as in the past, if the weather is 22 degrees or below (including wind chill,) we will have an inside day. Any weather that will get children WET, (not snow flurries,) will also be cause for inside day. There will definitely be exceptions if school is notified by parents in advance, for instance, if student has asthma or some sort of lung disease, they'll be allowed/required to stay inside. Any temporary reason that a parent requests for their child will be granted up to 3 days onlyafter that, a dr. note is required

Lunch-Children complain about not getting enough time to finish their food before heading out for recess. Apparently, there has been some confusion that faculty can clear up with the kids. Lunch/Recess break is 35 minutes total. There is not a strict time limit within that; they can eat during their entire recess if they'd like, but kids usually choose to head outside because their friends are. At 10 minute time-mark, the 'PAW' gets flipped meaning children are allowed (not required) to head out for recess. They can move to a specific table if they want to stay in the lunchroom longer-if they're actually eating, not goofing off. At the 20 minute time-mark, they have to get in line to head back to class-leaving them no time to play at recess. Trish has worked hard, and been successful, at getting kids through the lines quickly this year so that they have plenty of time to eat their food
